#### **WHAT IS STAR:**

STAR has been serving transportation needs of the community's older adults and individuals with disabilities since 1982. It is supported by a millage of the townships of Bruce and Washington, a Specialized Service Grant from the State of Michigan, Community and Municipal Credits from SMART, and is a Community Based Service Provider with SMART.

#### **ELGIBILITY:**

Must be a resident of the Village of Romeo, or the townships of Bruce or Washington, and 60 years of age or older, or under 60 years of age and have a disability that prevents them from operating a vehicle.

#### WHAT STAR DOES:

Take passengers for any transportation request, such as medical appointments, banks, groceries, drug stores, and hair appointments, nutritional and recreational activities, in the Village of Romeo and the Townships of Bruce and Washington. STAR travels outside the townships for personal medical appointments. This includes the Henry Ford Macomb area, Ascension Providence Rochester area, and the Troy Beaumont area.






